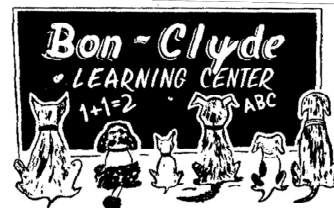

Class Information

Some classes may not be offered each session

Puppy Kindergarten: This class is generally for puppies between the ages of 12 weeks to 6 months old. A few of the topics covered in the course will be socializing your puppy, nipping and bite inhibition, beginning obedience (sit, down, stay, and come), discussion on nail clipping and teeth cleaning, plus use of small obstacles for confidence building. **Puppies must have Rabies vaccine to attend class.**

Beginner Skills: This class is for dogs 6 months and over. The course will consist of teaching the sit, down, stay, come when called and walking on a loose leash, along with control and manners. All exercises will be done on a leash.

Transitional Performance Skills: This class is for dogs that have completed basic obedience. Emphasis will be placed on more control and improving your dog's sit, down, stay, and come when called. You will be taught skills to prepare you for the CGC/TDI test, or agility, rally, or competition obedience. A variety of skills will be taught using motivational methods. You and your dog will be introduced to various games and exercises to achieve these skills. This is a class which you and your dog will love and learn a lot.

Intro to Agility Obstacles: This class is for dogs that have completed a course in Basic and Intermediate Skills or with prior approval. Dogs must know the commands: sit, down, stay, and come with distractions, as well as have on and off lead control. Dogs and handlers will learn how to safely execute the obstacles and practice skills necessary for entering the more advanced classes.

Pre-Novice Agility: This class is for dogs that have completed Intro to Agility Obstacles. Dogs must be performing intermediate level obstacles. Foundation level handling skills will be introduced and dogs will continue obstacle skill training.

Agility Competition Novice/Open: Learn how to handle those challenging sequences, work on obstacle performance, and much more. This class is for dogs that have a good foundation on all equipment and are competing or preparing to compete in Novice. Participants will work on successfully handling difficult courses, problem solving, and improving handling strategies and techniques.

Agility Competition:Open/Exc. A: This competition level class is geared towards handlers that are competing with their dogs in Open and /or Excellent A. Participants will work on successfully handling difficult courses, problem solving, and improving handling strategies and techniques. **Dogs must have Novice title or prior approval.**

Agility Competition:exc. B/Masters/Elite: This competition level class is geared toward handlers competing in Excellent B. Participants will work on difficult courses, problem solving, and improving handling. **Dogs must have AX,MAD, EAC or prior approval.**

Canine Acting: This class will cover the skills necessary to become a canine actor. Basic skills and more advanced topics will be covered. To enter this class, your dog must have a firm sit, down, stay, and come when called around distractions. Advanced students will build on skills their dogs already have while beginners will learn the basics.

Novice Rally Obedience: This class will focus on preparing dogs for competition rally obedience. Basic heeling and exposure to the different levels of Rally Obedience signs will be covered. Dogs should have completed Intermediate/Pre-Agility or have prior approval.

Advanced Rally Obedience: This class will focus on preparing dogs for advanced rally obedience. Advanced heeling and exposure to the different levels of Rally Obedience signs will be covered. Dogs should have completed Novice Rally Obedience or have prior approval.

Breed Handler Class: This class is designed to prepare both handler and dog for competing in the conformation ring. This class is now held in conjunction with our regular classes. Please mark your calendars.

Really Reliable Recall: Join us for a totally positive, reward based class that will teach your dog the life-saving skill of coming when called, regardless of distractions. With the information and exercises presented, you will be well on your way to having a recall that gets your dog to come to you immediately in emergency situations as well as enhancing your everyday recall. Dogs must be at least 6 months old and have no aggression issues. **No dogs first week.**

Beginners Skills for Novice Competition Obedience: Dogs will learn foundation skills required for Beginner Novice and Novice Competition. Emphasis will be on attention, heel position fronts, finishes, stay and recall.

Advanced Novice/Open Skills for Competition Obedience: Dogs will continue to improve on Beginner Novice Skills and introduce Open skills. Broad, drop on recall, proof stays, and continue heeling with distraction.

Independent Work Sessions:

Independent Work – Obedience: All dogs are invited to attend our “open” obedience time. Handlers may work on training their dogs, problem solving, socializing their dogs, etc. Dogs must be under control and not have aggression issues. **Health records must be on file.**
